Summer Camp:

Our summer camp is scheduled from June 3-6; 9:00-12:00. All players are expected to be at camp every day helping to run the drills and teach the campers volleyball skills. If you are unable to help with camp, please let your coach know.

Practice:

Practices are mandatory. Absences must be communicated to the coach to be excused. If a player misses a day of school, they may not participate in practice.

Practice days and times will be determined by the beginning of the school year.

Costs Associated with the Season: \$350.00

- Includes 3 practice t-shirts, 2 pairs of spandex, 1 Quarter Zip Pull Over Shirt, 3 pairs of socks, 1 set of knee pads, tournament fees, player plus 1 additional ticket to the End of Season Banquet.
- **\$150.00** of the above fee is due in May at the time of ordering the player packs. This is non-refundable due to the ordering of the player pack.
- The remaining **\$200.00** is due no later than Spike Night in August. You can also pay any time over the summer, in any increments as desired.

Fundraising:

Fundraising is a vital part of the volleyball program. It helps our program to purchase new equipment, new uniforms, recognize our seniors on senior night and recognize all players and coaches at the end of season banquet. This can either be done through selling sponsorships or the fundraising opportunity provided for the season. (Please see attached information for this year's fundraising opportunity)

Our program relies on fundraising and we encourage everyone to participate.

Sponsorships:

All sponsorships need to be approved by the Board before being accepted. Forms can be found on our website. Please send your sponsorship request to: etowahevbc@gmail.com for approval. Once approved, you may then submit the sponsorship form along with the check.

Why do we need to approve sponsorships in advance? We need to be compliant with Etowah and Cherokee County School District rules and agreements.

- No Rehab/PT sponsorships will be allowed
- No Plumbing services will be allowed due to a non-compete agreement with Superior Plumbing
- Any medical, dental, chiropractic or family practice sponsorships may be submitted for approval.

All approved sponsorships are due no later than Spike Night in August when the remaining balance of player fees are due. No exceptions will be made.

- Anyone who obtains a new sponsorship will receive a \$100.00 credit toward the remaining balance of the player fee with full payment of the sponsorship at Spike Night.
- All sponsorship renewals will also receive a \$100.00 credit toward the remaining balance of the player fee with full payment of the sponsorship at Spike Night.
- The maximum credit a player can receive is \$100.00 per sponsor, with a maximum total credit to not exceed \$350.00 based on having 4 or more sponsors.

Publix Partners:

Volunteers:

Volunteering is huge part of our programs success. All parents are expected to volunteer at the volleyball games. Our games cannot run smoothly without the help of our parents. Parents will be needed to help score keep, line judge, flip or libero track at home games and may also be needed to help out at away games. We will also need concession stand volunteers at our home games. In addition to helping at the games, we also need a few parents who are willing to be in charge of the committees listed below.

- **Team Parent** – communicates all information from the coach to your team
- **Food Coordinator** – works with the team parent to make sure food tables and pre-game meals are scheduled
- **Concessions** – order all drinks, buy food and schedule parent volunteers to work home games
- **Work Station Coordinator** – schedules parents for each station needed for home and away games
- **Senior Night** – Work with the board to organize and set up for Senior Night
